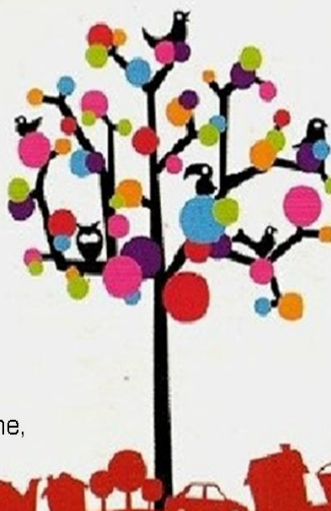
Agape Cafe
